



In the existing MyFileGateway(known in Nets as eNett2) solution, there is a Mailbox Path choice for our customer, which makes no sense for the Nets customers/ Data supplier.



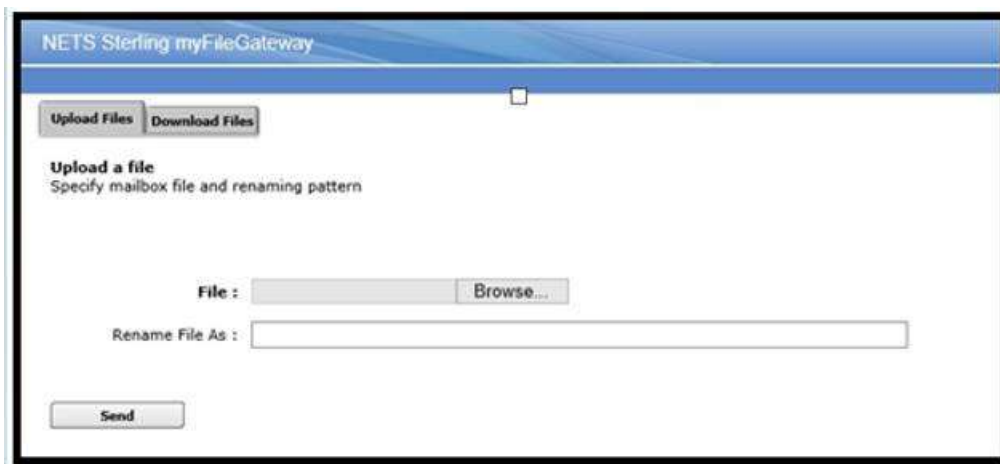

We like the screen look like this, because it will minimize the risk of sending data to one-self.



The risk for the existing solution is that the customers/ Data supplier is able, by choosing mailbox Path / to send data to one-self. To minimize that risk, we recommend to remove this option.

The risk by sending data to one-self is that nets customer is able to send data to one-self, and still believe that they have send data to Nets. This situation is unacceptable for our customers/ Data supplier.

The purpose of entering the screen is to send data to Nets, and therefore it makes no sense that customers/ Data supplier are able to send to one-self.

My recommendation is that the Mailbox Path feature should be removed.
